Lesson Overview

Objectives

Develop a understanding of the basic features of Graphic Editing Software including:

- Filter Adjustment options

- Task 1Create the James Bond Image using the Filter Adjustment options.
- Task 2 Filtered colours Image

Black & White (Desaturate)

- 1) Open the New York Image
- 2) Apply the Black and White colour effect

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Copy Selection

3) Open the Daniel Craig Image.

4) Select Daniel Craig using the Selection Tool



5) Copy and paste the Daniel Craig image appropriately on to the New York Image.

Resize the image if necessary



Black & White

6) Open the Bond Image.

7) Use the Magic Wand Tool to select the black shapes on the outside of the silhouette. Press Shift to make multiple selections.



8) Copy and paste the selection onto the main image.



Opacity

10) Click on the newly imported layer.

Graphics

11) Drag the opacity level to a lower number to make the layer transparent.

Slide to decrease level of opacity.



New Layer is now transparent.



Colour Adjustment

12) Click on Filter > Adjust and then click on Colour Adjustment curves.

Edit the curves to apply the effect

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Task 2: Filtered Colours

- 1) Open the New York Image
- 2) Duplicate the layer
- 3) Apply the **Desaturate** effect to the top layer to make it black and white.
- 4) Use the eraser tool to delete parts of the B&W layer to expose the colour from the layer below.
