

# **Writing and Editing Text**

- 1) Create a New File and set an the Canvas Size to 2000, 400.
- 2) Using the Text Tool write out the Text of your Favorite City.
- 3) Edit the text using the text properties panel.

Text Tool




### **Inserting Images over Text**

4) Copy and paste an image over the first letter.

You can resize and move the picture by selecting the picture layer and pressing Ctrl+T on your keyboard.

5) Reduce the opacity of the layer to see the letter behind.




## **Deleting Selections of the Image**

6) Using the Select Tool, select part of the image you want to remove.

7) Then click on Edit >> Cut.

You may need to repeat the step if you want to cut the other side of the image.




# Clipping



8) Select all the layers by pressing CTRL on your keyboard.






10) Click on the Clipping
Option to create the masking
effect. Increase the opacity of
all the layers to 100%.

### **Masking Result**




Masking (clipping) effect has been applied. The opacity of the layers has been increased to 100%.


1) Open an image and use the selectPen Tool to fill in the image you want to select.








SelectPen Tool is used to <u>fill</u> in your selection




SelectEraser Tool is used to <u>delete</u> parts of your selection.

- 2) You can preview your selection by clicking on the lasso tool.
- 3) Copy and then paste your selection which will create a new layer.
- 4) Delete the layer containing the original image.








To deselect your selection click on:

Select >>> Deselect

- 5) Copy and paste suitable images over the main image. Press CTRL+T to position and resize the images.
- 6) Reduce the opacity of the picture and adjust the position if necessary.
- 7) Use the eraser tool to soften the edges around each image.







Opacity set to 57%

8) Select all the layers by pressing CTRL on your keyboard.

9) Click on the Clipping Option to create the masking effect. Increase the opacity of all the layers if necessary.
